

2020 Bellville Livestock - Junior Fair

Location: Tractor Pull Track behind Jefferson Twp. Fire Station – 470 Main St. Bellville

Summary: To be compliant with the mandates and recommendations from Ohio Gov. Mike DeWine and the Richland County Health Department, livestock will not stay on the grounds. Animals will only be present for their scheduled show day. Animals will be shown. There will be both market and breeding shows. There will be showmanship. There will be an online livestock auction. There will be no buy-bid for animals. The exhibitor is responsible for removal of his/her market animal. Please see below for specifics.

Proof of Possession: Photos of market animals were submitted with entry forms except for goats and lambs. For those species, scrapie tags were written on entry forms. Poultry must provide a copy of hatchery papers at time of weigh-in. Rabbits must provide copy of bill at sale at weigh-in.

Tagging: All market animals will be tagged with a Bellville Fair approved ear tag at weigh-in for identification purposes. Poultry will be leg banded.

Sale Information

- There will be an online auction for all market animals.
- Participation is required.
- Conducted by Whatman Auctioneers
- Sale will run Tuesday, September 15 at 5:00 PM through Sunday, September 20 at 8:00 PM.
- Exhibitors will submit appropriate photo for online auction.
- There will be no buy-bids for any market animals. Only premium auction bid.
- The standard 5% commission will be deducted from each sale to cover operating expenses.
- No animals will be “kept”. If a buyer wants to purchase an animal for his personal use, he will need to contact exhibitor directly.

Exhibitor Information

- With the exception of hogs, only limited pens will be available. Plan on keeping your animals on trailer or in your cage prior to show.
- Limited washing facility available.
- Water for animals is available.
- Concessions will be on the grounds.
- Champion market animals (*applicable only to steers, hogs, lambs, & goats*)
 - Grand & Reserve market animals must be processed at designated processing facility.
 - Fair Board will transport champions to processor.
 - Champions will be available for purchase in online auction.
 - Only champion animals have processing appointments.
